**1. TRUSTEES :**

Trustees mean and include the Board of Trustees as described in these presents, and those next Trustees, as appointed, nominated or settled by the remaining members of the Board of Trust whenever any vacancy arises.

**2. NAME :**

The name of the Trust shall be **A.A. MEMORIAL EDUCATIONAL TRUST**.

**3. CREATION OF THE TRUST :**

In pursuance of the intention, the **AUTHOR OF THE TRUST** has settled the sum of Rs. 50,000/- ( Rupees Fifty Thousand ) only by cash unto and in favor of the Trustees herein to be held by them for and on behalf of the Trust hereby created and known as **A.A. MEMORIAL EDUCATIONAL TRUST** the receipt of which sum of Rs. 50,000/- ( Rupees Fifty Thousand ) only which has already been handed over to the trustees mentioned hereunder, is hereby acknowledge by the Trustees, who hereby accept the appointment as such Trustees if the said Trust, under the terms and conditions, set out hereunder for the fulfillment of the objects of the Trust, more fully and particularly described and set out hereunder.

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However the maximum strength of Board of the Trustee of the Trust may be 7 (Seven) and the remaining 4 (Four) Trustee may be appointed by the present Board of Trustee of the Trust in any meeting after the creation of the Trust, which shall be the option of the Board of Trustees and such new members if taken shall be by majority votes.

**6. OBJECTS OF THE TRUST :**

- a) The primary objective is to establish a school which emphasizes on imparting quality education along with exposure to other group activities and co-curricular activities which helps in Improving a child's mental as well as social approach.
- b) To promote welfare, social-cultural, charitable, health education, humanitarian and relief activities that will protect, safeguard, improve the quality and raise the standard of human life, particularly economically weaker sections of the society, irrespective of caste creed, race, color, sex or religion so that they may lead healthy, happy contented and dignified life.
- c) To offer scholarships, stipends and financial support deserving students in pursuing higher studies in Medicine, Art, science, Engineering, Computer technology etc.
- d) To undertake and support any program or projects that provide educational, recreational, social cultural and spiritual activities with the sole purpose of promoting peace, love, tolerance and national integration among the various communities of the country and Nationalities of the world.

- e) Sponsorship of economically weak persons for institutional care.
- f) Collaboration with other voluntary organizations to accomplish the above objects.
- g) Affiliation with other voluntary organizations to accomplish the above objects.
- h) Regular dialogue and rapport with Central, State Government and NGO's to elicit support and co-operation in fulfilling the aims and objects of the organization(Charitable Trust).
- i) To acquire immovable and movable properties by purchase lease, mortgage, gifts, grants, legacy, bequest, right privilege from any person/s, company, society, Government cooperative bodies or institutions whatsoever and to hold movable and immovable properties lawfully held of all descriptions.
- j) To erect/build school buildings, hostels, hospitals and any other type of buildings or structure whatsoever, to further any objects of the Charitable Trust and to maintain, manage, control, improve, alter, repairs, demolish or reconstruct the same or any portions thereof.
- k) To receive by way of Gift, whether in cash movable and immovable, donations and contributions in any legal form, including legacy, behest, wills, trusteeship, etc. for the benefit of the Charitable Trust.
- l) To alienate by way of sale, mortgage, lease, charge transfer all or any part of the property of the Charitable Trust.
- m) To invest and reinvest any funds or money of the Charitable Trust in the interest of the beneficiaries of the Trust.
- n) To execute such agreements, conveyances, transfers, lease license, mortgages, documents etc. as may be deemed necessary to carry out the objects of the Charitable Trust.
- o) To borrow and raise any funds with or without security in any manner the charitable trust may think to repay the same.
- p) To negotiate with or enter into arrangements with different authorities, bodies, industrial house for grants, allowances, rights, concessions, and privileges etc. that may be beneficial to the Charitable trust beneficiaries.
- q) To use all the income from the properties movable and immovable or from the earning of the Charitable Trust as such who so ever derived from, solely for the advancement of the objects. And that no portion of it be distributed or disbursed among the Trustees by way of profits, bonuses or dividends. However, nothing herein contained shall prevent the payment in good faith in the shape of remuneration or reimbursement to any Trustees for any services rendered to the charitable trust or expenses incurred thereto.
- r) To appoint or to remove staff of different graces, prescribed their duties assignments, service conditions and to fix their wages, remunerations, and perquisites, etc.

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- s) To perform all acts as are incidental and conducive to the attainment of all or any of the objects of the Charitable Trust.
- t) The income and earnings of the charitable trust shall be utilized to attain the aims and objects of the organization as described by the Trustees of the Charitable Trust.
- u) To undertake and promote human resources in the field of Social work and in other science relating to social action for world peace.
- v) To undertake, maintain and assist any relief measures in those parts which become subject to natural calamities such as flood, fire, drought famine, cyclone, earth-quake epidemics, storm, accidents, pestilence, etc.
- w) To give, provide and/or render, help and assistance to and/or implement any scheme for providing livelihood and upliftment of the poor.

**7. BENEFIT OF THE TRUST :**

The benefit of the trust are open to all irrespective of Caste, religion, race, sex etc. That the Trust will not carry on any activities with an intention of earning profit.

**8. THE PROPERTIES OF THE TRUST :**

The properties of the Trust shall be :

- (a) The said sum of Rs. 50,000/- ( Rupees Fifty Thousand ) only above referred to the receipt of which is hereby acknowledge by the Trustees.
- (b) Any properties movable and immovable, that may be acquired by the Trust either by purchase or otherwise.
- (c) All additions and acceptations to the Trust fund.
- (d) All voluntary donations both towards corpus or otherwise gifts, legacies or grants in cash or in kind accepted by the trustees.
- (e) All grants and contributions made to the Trust by the Government, Government bodies, Trust or Institutions, Trade Union of Societies etc. and
- (f) All sums and assets which by and means become the property of the Trust.

**9. QUALIFICATION OF THE TRUSTEES :**

The qualification of the Trustees shall be

- a) Sound Mind
- b) Integrity
- c) Good Listening Skills

**10. CESSATION OF THE TRUSTSHIP :**

A Trustee mentioned above shall cease to be the trustee of the Trust if :

- a) He resigns or

- b) He become insolvent or
- c) He is removed by the majority of the members of the trust, if it is found that the Trustee(s) activities are detrimental to the activities or administration or funds of the Trust.

**11. APPOINTMENT OF THE TRUSTEES :**

If and whenever the member of Board of Trustee reduce due to some contingency, resignation, retirement, insane, or otherwise, the contingent trustee of the Board shall appoint new trustee within a period of 6 months and that will be done by the decision of the majority members of the Trust to make effective the strength of the trustee.

**12. ADMINISTRATION OF THE TRUST :**

The administration of the Trust shall vest with the Board of Trustees, which consist of :

- a) One Managing Trustee
- b) One Joint Managing Trustee
- c) One Treasurer.

**13. POWER OF THE TRUSTEES :**

The Board of Trustees shall have the control and management of the Trust and exercise of the following powers :

- a) To determine from time to time to commence and to take up the objects and purpose for which the funds of trust shall be used and allot and allocate to each of the objects such portion of the funds as they deem fit.
- b) To purchase and acquire any immovable property of any kind for this object of the Trust or as a source of income for the Trust.
- c) To sell, mortgage, or dispose of any immovable property/properties belonging to the Trust.
- d) To incur all expenditure necessary as in their own opinion useful for carrying out the objects and administration of the Trust.
- e) To sell, lease, mortgage or dispose of any property, immovable property/properties belonging to the Trust.
- f) To open one or more bank accounts of the trust with any bank or banks as the Trustees may deem fit and deposit monies of the Trust in the Bank accounts.
- g) To borrow for and on behalf of the Trust with or without security from banks, Governments, Universities or any other Government body/bodies both Central and state.

- h) To employ staff of all kinds necessary and useful for carrying out the objects of the Trust.
- i) To incur such items of expenditure as is necessary and incidental for carrying out the objects of the Trust.
- j) To institute, conduct, defend, compound, withdraw, compromise, adjust, refer to arbitration or to do such things as are incidental and necessary concerning the affairs of the Trust and to sign and verify vakalats, pleadings, affidavits and other powers.
- k) To delegate all or any of the powers vested in the trustees to any body to frame rules, bylaws and other codes for the conduct of the affairs of the trust and its transactions and establishing any Committee.
- l) To accept contributions in cash or in kind either by way of addition to the trust funds generally or for any one or more of the specified objects of the Trust.
- m) To establish as many adhoc committees for any purpose.

**14. MEETINGS OF THE TRUSTEES :**

- a) The Managing Trustee shall preside over all the meetings of the trustees and in his absence the Joint Managing Trustee shall preside such meeting and in the absence of both, the trustees attended such meeting may elect any one of them to preside over the meeting.
- b) The meetings of the Trustees may be convened by the Managing Trustee or under his direction by any other Trustees.
- c) The quorum of the meetings of the Trustees shall be for personally present.
- d) In the event of equality of votes, the person presiding such meeting shall exercise casting vote(additional vote).

**15. RESOLUTIONS :**

- a) The Trustees may exercise all the powers vested in them in clause 13 under these presents by resolution passed or a simple majority of the trustees attended such meetings of the Board of Trustees.
- b) Any resolution in writing signed by all Trustees holding office for the time being shall be valid and binding.

**16. SUITS :**

The Managing Trustee of the Trust is authorized to sue or to be sued on behalf of the Trust.

**17. EXECUTION OF DOCUMENTS :**

All Deeds, Documents etc. shall be executed by the Managing Trustee, Joint Managing Trustee and Deputy Managing Trustee jointly representing the Trust.

**18. ACCOUNTS AND AUDIT :**

- a) The Trustee shall maintain true and correct of all Trust monies and of all the income and investments and all outgoing expenses.
- b) The year of account shall be the financial year commencing from 1<sup>st</sup> April and ending 31<sup>st</sup> March.
- c) The Trustees shall each year issue a report setting out the accounts showing the income and the expenditure of the Trust for the preceding year not later than six months from the end of the preceding year of accounts.
- d) The accounts of the Trust shall be audited every year by a Chartered Accountant who may be appointed for the purpose by the board of Trustees and the audited statement of accounts together with Auditor' report shall be laid before the Board of Trustees for approval.

**19. FUNDS :**

The Trustee may accept Donations, grants, subscriptions, aids or contributions from any person, Government, local Authorities or any other Charitable Institutions, in cash or in kind including immovable property without any encumbrance, but the Trustee shall not accept any receipt with any condition or terms inconsistent with the objects of the Trust. While applying such receipts to the objects, the Trustees shall respect the direction if any by the Grantors. Any receipts with specified direction to treat the same as part of the corpus of the Trust or separate fund shall be funded accordingly.

**20. BANK ACCOUNTS :**

The Managing Trustee along with the Treasurer shall operate bank account(s) jointly.

**21. POWER TO ALTER RULES AND REGULATIONS :**

The Board of Trustee shall have full power and authority to make, alter and rescind rules and regulations for the management and administration of the Trust. Any amendment to the Trust Deed will be carried out with the approval of the Commissioner of Income Tax.

**22. APPLICATION OF INCOME AND TRUST FUND :**

The Board of Trustees shall be empowered to invest the funds of the Trust in movable or immovable properties, in such manner as they deem fit for the purpose of the objects of the Trust provided that such investments shall be in accordance with the provision of Section 13(1) read with Section 11(5) of the Income Tax Act, 1961 as well as of any other law for the time being in force as are applicable to Charitable Trusts.

**23. REMUNERATION OF THE TRUSTEES :**

The Trustees are not entitled for any remuneration. But they shall however be entitled to receive out of pocket expenses incurred by them in the course of discharging the functions of the trust. Further the Income and funds of the Trust will be solely utilized towards the objects and no portion of it will be utilized for payments of Trustees by way of profits, interest, dividend or otherwise.

**24. INDEMNITY :**

Every Trustee shall be indemnified out of the fund in respect of any loss arising from or contingent upon any investment made out of the monies of the Trust unless such loss shall have been occasioned by own negligence and also every Trustee shall be indemnified out of the Trust against all proceedings, suits, claims, costs, damages and expenses occasioned by any claim in connection with the matters or affairs relating to the Trust created by these presents or in the exercise of powers or discretion vested in them by virtue of these presents.

**25. ACTIVITIES OF THE TRUST :**

The activities of the Trust shall be only within India and its Union Territories and shall not be extended anywhere outside India.

**26. DISSOLUTION :**

On dissolution of the Trust, the net assets of the Trust shall be transferred to an association of persons or trust or society having similar objects of this Trust.

**27. PROCEEDING OF THE TRUST :**

Any defect in the constitution of the Trust shall not invalidate its proceedings.

**28. RESIDUARY :**

For matters not provided for in these presents, the provisions of the Indian Trust Act and the Income Tax Act, 1961 and rules made there under will apply accordingly..


